FACTS FOUND ITA 391 (39ft) was subject to a post race measurement check. The measurer found one anchor of about 10kg and another anchor of 2.5kg (umbrella type). There is one chain of 10 m on the boat for the two anchors, but two ropes. None of the anchors were attached to the chain or one of the ropes.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY ITA 391 did not comply with OSR 4.06 which reads " 2 suitable anchors with suitable combination of chain and rope, ready for immediate use". The International Jury ruled this infringement as a minor breach of the rule.
